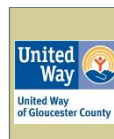

A Success Story About...Greg

Greg is a 23-year-old man who attends our Twenty-One Plus Program. Greg has respiratory and nutritional needs. He is also a heart transplant recipient that continues to astonish his doctors with his resilience and ability to thrive and grow.

Although he doesn't speak Greg follows everything that goes on in his classroom and out on his trips bowling, shopping, fishing, visits to museums and parks such as Longwood Gardens this year. Facial grimaces and an excited shaking of his fist and foot let you know he wants your attention.

His mother provides all his care "around the clock" including oxygen, tube feeding and medication. She has told us "in-home" nursing feels intrusive. Our nurses' work closely with Mom under Greg's doctors' supervision, so that mom feels comfortable knowing his needs are being met. While Greg socializes with his friends in class and on outings, Mom has an opportunity to attend to household and personal needs and prepare for Greg's return.
