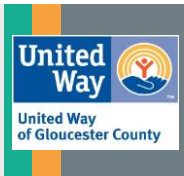


HOLLYDELL - Twenty-One Plus

Bryan is a 29-year-old man who attends our T.O.P. Program. He has multiple medical conditions that need to be addressed daily to meet his activities of daily living. Bryan's nurse at T.O.P. provides daily g-tube feeding by pump and



venting as needed. Stomach care and g-tube replacement is also provided if necessary. When Bryan has a prolonged seizure, his emergency medications must be administered through the g-tube. Bryan may also require oxygen administration and vital sign monitoring during seizure activity. The T.O.P. Program, in collaboration with his parents, physician, and program nurses, provide the support he needs to enjoy an active social life. He enjoys bowling, picnics, fishing, movies, trips to the boardwalk, and museums. He greatly enjoys the company of his friends on these outings. The nursing support we provide allows him to fully participate in these activities, and his family has comfort in knowing that he is well cared-for while they continue their routines and employment.
