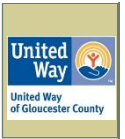


# MARYVILLE

Residential Substance Abuse Treatment and Mental Health Intervention



## A Success Story About...John

John is a 45 year old male who had been drinking alcohol since age 12. He consumed up to 1 gallon of vodka each day. He was referred to Maryville by the crisis center at the hospital. He had been previously diagnosed with anxiety, but had stopped seeing his psychiatrist and stopped taking his medication. Through continued drinking, John had developed alcoholic cirrhosis.



John came to Maryville in January of 2016 for detox and short term residential services. After he was treated for withdrawal, John was able to meet with the psychiatric nurse practitioner. He received a psychiatric evaluation, along with co-occurring counseling during his stay. He was placed back on the medication he needed. Upon completion of the short term stay, John went home where he was able to reconcile with his fiancé. He attends to his medical and mental health needs by regularly seeing his primary care doctor, psychiatrist, and private counselor as part of his aftercare plan. He was able to secure employment, but has expressed a desire to become a certified drug and alcohol counselor.
