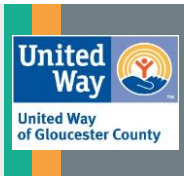


## MARYVILLE - Residential Substance Abuse Treatment & Mental Health Intervention

Patrick is a 54-year-old Caucasian male with a 30-year history of severe alcohol use disorder and depression. Prior to his admission to Maryville, his wife left him due to his drinking and the rest of the family stopped talking to him. He sought out treatment as a way to get his life together.



After he completed 3.7WM (detox), he was referred to the APN for a psychiatric evaluation. Patrick was diagnosed with Unspecified Depressive Disorder. He was prescribed Celexa to stabilize his symptoms, and successfully completed short-term residential treatment at Maryville. He reports having a positive experience at Maryville, and continues to go to AA Meetings. He has been working side jobs as they come to him, and is currently looking for full-time employment.
