Currently through the traditional Scouting Program, we have only reached 2.2% of the Cub Scout youth in Gloucester County (out of 24,776 youth available to become a Cub Scout, presently only 538 are Cub Scouts). Through United Way funding, the impact of the ScoutReach Program will allow us to be able to provide a positive impact for our underserved youth in Paulsboro this year, helping our youth with the tools they need to make moral and ethical decisions over their lifetime.
