Rebecca came to Mother Child Residential alone and scared. During her stay, she was ineligible for TANF and other assistance from the Board of Social Services due to the unemployment assistance she was receiving. But thanks to the grant from United Way of Gloucester County she was able to receive the care and connections to resources she so desperately needed. Mother Child provided a safe place to live for Rebecca. Just a few weeks after finding care there, she was making plans to return to school, search for a job, and work through the trauma she experienced thanks to individual counseling sessions. Additionally, Rebecca was connected to affordable housing, provided with vouchers, and received support with a security deposit thanks to Catholic Charities.

Today, Rebecca is back in school, working full time, and living a self-sufficient life in her own home. She has also found a new sense of confidence in herself that will surely carry her through the next phase of her life.
