Famcare

United Way of Gloucester County funding crucially supports various healthcare services for low-income, uninsured and underinsured women at Famcare. This covers colposcopy, thin prep (Pap test), and HPV testing. Individuals who are not eligible for Medicaid receive comprehensive reproductive healthcare and preventative health education through this funding. Access to ultrasounds at South Jersey Radiology is provided under the Famcare contract, with associated costs covered by United Way funding.
