In April 2024, Natalie became homeless with her daughter. She had no family support and no one to rely on. When she arrived at Mother Child, she was feeling overwhelmed and hopeless.

The staff encouraged Natalie to stay positive and take one step at a time. Natalie was connected to resources and provided case management, advocacy, and a stable living situation, which gave her the support, confidence, and guidance she needed to overcome challenging life circumstances.

During her stay at Mother Child, Natalie attended worshops that helped her with parenting, budgeting, and how to prepare for a job interview. She also learned how to navigate the housing market.

She now has a full-time job, her daughter is in school, and she secured permanent housing through her own income. Thanks to Mother Child, Natalie and her daughter are ready to move into permanent housing.
