Stacey's childhood was full of challenges. She was exposed to domestic violence at a young age and spent most of her youth growing up in foster care. These experiences forced Stacey to grow up quickly and without a strong support system.

In June 2019, Stacey found herself pregnant and homeless with nowhere to turn. She was in an unhealthy relationship and knew she had to get out for the sake of her children. Thankfully, she found Center for Family Services' Mother Child program. Not only was Mother Child able to provide Stacey and her children with a safe place to live, but they offered her a real chance to become self-sufficient. During Stacey's time with Mother Child, she learned financial literacy, interview skills, and with time, began to heal from the trauma she had experienced throughout her life.

Today, Stacey and her children are preparing for the next step in their journey toward independence and healing as they move into a supportive apartment. "Mother Child is one of the most influential stepping stones for any homeless mother that I could ever recommend," reflects Stacey. "They help you to stay on the right path so you will never experience homelessness again."
