Patient H, a 37-year-old undocumented woman residing in Gloucester County, sought services at Famcare for her annual visit and to explore birth control options. Juggling the responsibilities of caring for her five school-age children, she expressed the desire not to expand her family at the present time. During discussions with a Famcare provider, Patient H found Nexplanon to be a contraceptive option that fit her needs. Nexplanon is an implantable device placed in the patient's arm, providing contraception for up to three years. However, the drawback is the cost of the device and the insertion procedure. Given Patient H's undocumented status, she faced the challenge of covering this expense out of her own pocket.

Fortunately, Famcare extends a helping hand by offering a sliding scale payment option. This ensures that individuals, irrespective of their immigration status, can access the necessary care and make decisions that align with their health and life choices, free from financial barriers.
