Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, FamCare has seen an increase in the number of individuals that no longer have health insurance. We provided services to a 50-year old woman that no longer had health insurance through her husband's health plan since he lost his job due to COVID-19. She was having some GYN issues and having UWGC funding allowed us to provide the care she needed.

We also had a mom bring in her teenage daughter who was having gynecologic issues. The teen was not sexually active but this provided FamCare staff the opportunity to develop a relationship with mom and her daughter. Services that were provided included parent-teen communication, normal adolescent development, and a demonstration to the parent and teen that client focused confidential services are provided at FamCare irrespective of ability to pay.
