A Success Story featuring...

M.C.



M.C., a 36-year-old uninsured Spanish-speaking woman, came to Famcare for a routine annual exam and to discuss birth control options. During the visit, a Pap smear and HPV test were performed, and the results showed a Low Grade Squamous Intraepithelial Lesion (LSIL) with a positive result for HPV, which is associated with an increased risk of cervical cancer. Given the abnormal results, the Famcare team recommended a colposcopy for further evaluation. However, M.C. was unable to afford the cost of the procedure on her own.

Thanks to UWGC funding, Famcare was able to provide M.C. with the necessary diagnostic services, including the colposcopy. The timely diagnosis allowed her to receive appropriate treatment and avoid more severe complications. M.C. is also scheduled for regular Pap smears and HPV testing to monitor for any progression of the disease.
