The United Way of Gloucester County funding impacts our program by enabling GCDC to meet its increased payroll obligation to support 3 staff needed to supervise the 30 students from ALICE households during the entire year. Mothers or female caregivers are still the last to return to the workforce post pandemic, and this opportunity to support them will impact their family's ability to begin to recover from losses in earnings, food, housing and other necessities. Glassboro Child Development Centers would not be able to support the proposed 30 students with reduced or waived fees, without the United Way funding. But because of it, 30 kids will not slip through the cracks. For those families, there is huge impact.
