



# GLASSBORO CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTERS PRESENTS: A SUCCESS STORY STARRING ... *Jasmine & Her Son*



“Hello, this is Jasmine. I wanted to see if you had an opening for my son – I wanted to transition him to Glassboro Child Development Centers. I picked up an application and the awesome young lady helped me. When I moved to New Jersey I was homeless due to a DV case with my son’s father, so his old center had me under a homeless grant. I am out on medical so I don’t have a job. I also take care of my mother full time as best as I can. I receive Medicaid, WIC, and food stamps. Do you know what program to apply for daycare assistance? This is new to me so I’d appreciate your help. I have applied for disability, but I’m still waiting to hear.”

Jasmine did not qualify for childcare subsidy. Her son has ADHD and needs additional behavioral support. Although she is ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed), she did not have the ability to work the required weekly hours. She was eventually approved for disability. We were able to use the United Way funding we received to assist her with tuition so he could attend the entire summer at 10% of cost. He did well with one of our additional staff from this grant and will be back this summer.
