What Impact Has United Way of Gloucester County Had on These Programs...?



Glassboro Child Development Centers



Funding by United Way of Gloucester County will impact our program by enabling Glassboro Child Development Centers to support three staff needed to supervise 30 students from ALICE (Asset Limited Income Constrained Employed... earning just above the Federal Poverty Level but less than what it costs to make ends meet) households during the entire year. Mothers or female caregivers are still the last to return to the workforce, and this opportunity to support them will impact their family's ability to begin to recover from the pandemic losses in finances, food, housing and other necessities. Without this funding, Glassboro Child Development Centers would not be able to support the proposed 30 students with reduced or waived fees.

Funding from the United Way of Gloucester County allows the individuals in the HollyDELL Adult Program to participate and be included in community activities on a regular basis. Without this funding, these individuals would be limited to going on community outings perhaps 2 to 3 times per year.
