SADIE

Sadie is in 3rd grade and her mom worries about the exposure at her school to the COVID-19 virus. She is enrolled in our full day remote/virtual learning program and receives one to one tutoring when necessary to navigate her online schooling. Because our program has a strict social distance, hand washing, masks and frequent cleaning protocol, Sadie has not only attended our summer program through the height of the pandemic in June-August 2020, she has had no Covid exposure at our program, and is thriving in the environment we've created at our school age virtual learning program.

Sadie's mom Tanya reported that during her first parent conference in November, her teacher noted that Sadie is one of only 3 students in the class who had completed all her assignments and logs into synchronous and asynchronous lessons consistently. The teacher, Mr. Severino stated that "whatever that program is you have her in, I wish it was available to more kids". We have heard this from many teachers. Sadie's is a particularly successful case because she has ADHD and is easily distracted.
