Jeffrey is a young man who has attended our day program for many years. He enjoys computer games, social times with friends, and musical activities. Jeffrey has recently participated in trips to the Aquarium, Riverlink Ferry, as well as fishing, bowling, movies and plays. He even caught a fish on his outing to Scotland Run!

Jeffrey has intense medical needs such as seizures, asthma and a predilection to pneumonia. He has a diagnosis of cerebral palsy, cortical blindness and chronic encephalopathy with a shunt. He receives nebulizer treatments regularly, uses a wheelchair for mobility, and is totally dependent on others for his physical care. Jeffrey eats a pureed diet for enjoyment but receives additional nutrition and medications via a g-tube. He is nonverbal and uses a Dynavox for communication.

Jeffrey receives daily care from our nursing staff which includes administering nebulizer treatments, chest PT, medications, nutrition via his g-tube, and seizure care if needed. With these nursing supports, Jeffrey is able to fully participate in all day program activities and outings, which he enjoys immensely.
