His nurses monitor and communicate with mom changes in his weight, digestion and gas issues and elimination patterns daily to help Evan stay healthy. His program nurse accompanies Evan on trips out into the community so he can enjoy the outdoor parks, zoos, fishing, bowling, movies and shopping trips to the mall and outlets. Evan also likes to “Party” with his friends at T.O.P during the many holidays that we celebrate. His favorite party game is limbo!

The COVID pandemic has caused the T.O.P. program to temporarily close and we are hoping to reopen soon following DDD and the state’s guidelines and recommendations.
