Stephany of Glassboro came to LNJ in the fall of 2018 in the hopes of enrolling in college classes, but she lacked a high school diploma and was limited by her low English skills. She did not test high enough to enroll in the high school equivalency preparation program at Rowan College of South Jersey. She was referred to LNJ, where she worked with her tutor and attended several English as a Second Language classes for a year. In the fall of 2019, Stephany was reassessed and had improved two proficiency levels on a state-approved standardized evaluation. She also tested high enough to enroll in the HSE program at the college, where she is working toward her high school diploma.

Stephany told us that she feels she is the most confident and talkative student in the class...traits she attributes to the Literacy NJ team who prepared her for the coursework. After she receives her diploma, Stephany plans to continue her education in the hopes of becoming a pharmacy technician. Literacy NJ is proud to have helped her begin her journey.
