

Maryville Integrated Care Presents:

A Success Story featuring... **Justin**



Justin, a Williamstown resident, began treatment at Maryville against his wishes but at the urging of his parents. Addicted to fentanyl and meth, he had overdosed and literally died multiple times, even using again just five minutes after one of these episodes. His parents knew that one of these times the EMTs might not be able to bring him back. Justin started out in the Turnersville site in 2022 where he would attend the Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP). Approximately a year ago, he began attending Maryville's Alumni Services program which helped motivate him to stay in treatment, and he made the decision to continue into Outpatient when he finished with IOP. Since then, he has been consistent in attending Alumni Services, where he has received mutual support with peers and support from Maryville. Today, he is clean, his relationship with his family is much improved, and he works part-time in landscaping. Justin shared, "Alumni Services really helps with the events that they do. I'm grateful that you guys have taken the opportunity to help me and others where we lost hope and didn't care anymore. I can say if it wasn't for Maryville, I would be locked up or dead."
