## **Center for People in Transition**



Funding from United Way of Gloucester County provides the Center for People in Transition the tools that Gloucester County residents need to become self-sufficient. It gives them the career skills needed to obtain employment and provide for their families. Sustainability is a crucial need for many families in our community. Our program's mission impacts the Gloucester County economy, and thanks to UWGC, we can provide the skills and education needed for clients to get back into the workforce and maintain employment.

United Way of Gloucester County funding supports colposcopy services, thin prep (Pap test), and HPV testing for low-income uninsured and underinsured women. Individuals who are not eligible for Medicaid receive comprehensive reproductive healthcare and preventative health education through this funding. Additionally, clients in need of ultrasounds receive these services at South Jersey Radiology through the Famcare contract. In these instances, Famcare covers the cost of the service utilizing United Way funding.
