



## **Center for People in Transition Presents: A Success Story About One of Our Clients**

Client started working with People in Transition in March of 2022. Client is a survivor of domestic violence who continued to be stalked and revictimized in court by her ex-husband. She was on disability because of the emotional abuse she endured. While in the relationship, she lost her massage business and her self-confidence. PIT connected her to domestic violence agencies where she started receiving counseling. She attended domestic violence support groups and worked on her mental health. She attended our computer literacy classes and worked with our program specialist on career skills. When her alimony stopped abruptly, she worked with the director on community resources that could assist her financially. PIT was able to assist the client with getting health insurance and rental assistance. We sent her job leads and provided support with applying for employment. Client found full time employment in November of 2022, making \$21 an hour. She reported feeling empowered and confident, and enrolled in the Central Services Technician course to increase her employability skills and obtain an even higher pay.
