### OUR CLIENT

Our Client is a single mother of two. She left an unhealthy relationship and move to N.J to be close to her support system. She got a job at a Daycare center, but her income wasn't sufficient to provide for her and her two daughters. Our Client struggled every month to make ends meet. In the attempt to keep up with her bills she worked an additional job babysitting.

Unfortunately, before the holidays, she got injured and required physical therapy. She couldn't afford medical copays, and was denied disability because she didn't live in NJ long enough to qualify. She found herself without income and two children. She contacted the Center for People in Transition seeking guidance. People in Transition connected her to different resources in the community. After obtaining assistance with her copays, groceries, Christmas gifts and utility bills, she enrolled in the EMT course and became the lead student in class. She graduated from the EMT course in December 2020 and was offered multiple opportunities upon completion.

She states: "If it wasn't for the Center for People in Transition I don't know where I would be. I'm extremely grateful for everything they've done for me"
