Repauno recently enrolled a child whose mother is an immigrant of Turkey. When *Ursula's* childcare provider informed her that they were closing their doors, she didn't know what to do. She reached out to the local child care resource and referral service (Rutgers), and they put her in contact with us. With English as her second language, it was difficult at best to navigate all of the forms required to transfer to another agency, let alone deal with new people. Being new to the area, she did not have many resources and was in an entry level job. We expedited her paperwork so her child would not miss out on any of her crucial Pre-K instruction, and she would not lose time from her job. The child and parent are managing well now, like they have been here forever. *Ursula* is very appreciative and enjoys conversation with staff to improve her English. Her daughter came in to express holiday sentiment in her mother's native language, further enhancing our children's program through diversity.
