Funding from United Way of Gloucester County significantly impacts the budget for Samaritan's Center for Grief Support. This program's budget is very tight each year, but the implementation of our virtual support platforms has empowered us to reach far more people and provide impactful care for an increasing number of individuals, while not greatly increasing our expenditures.

All funding provided through United Way of Gloucester County (UWGC) goes toward providing services to individuals experiencing homelessness who would otherwise be ineligible for emergency shelter services. The goals of this initiative are in alignment with Gloucester County's Five-Year Consolidation Plan to address housing and community development needs; therefore, funding provided through UWGC has an impact on the quality of life and economic well-being of the community as a whole. During their stay, clients served will have the opportunity to collaborate with case management to establish a written plan that details supports, activities, and resources required for the individual to achieve personal goals—including education services via the McKinney-Vento Act—and develop strategies for accessing permanent housing.
