The 2023 United Way of Gloucester County funding provided three single mothers with a total of 4 children, plus one single female for a total of 8 individuals, with short-term emergency shelter at the Volunteers of America Delaware Valley's Eleanor Corbett House. One individual that significantly stands out is A.B., a mother of two children who, prior to entering the shelter, was living with family members and had just had a baby, along with a two-year-old. When A.B. entered the facility, she was unsure as to what she wanted to do with her life. During her stay at Eleanor Corbett House, she managed to complete nursing school, received her CNA license, and was able to obtain employment. She expressed that being able to be here and save her funds will help her save for her transition into permanent housing. She is grateful for the Eleanor Corbett House Family Shelter and the United Way funding that permitted her family a safe haven during their time of need.
