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Program Overview

Lead Gloucester County is a comprehensive certification course that offers an in-depth exploration of Gloucester County, covering its populace, governmental departments and services, operational processes, employment sectors, industries, nonprofit organizations, and its challenges. Our objective is to cultivate well-informed, well-rounded and empathetic leaders through seminars, panel discussions, and tours, while actively involving them in addressing critical issues or concerns within the county. The program enhances the leadership training offered by employers, supports participants in advancing their careers, and prepares them to effectively serve on community boards and committees.

Program Structure

Lead Gloucester County spans nine months, with sessions held from September to May on the first Friday of each month on the Rowan College of South Jersey campus. The program tuition covers seminars, leadership training, lunches, and tour-related transportation. Each class consists of 24 diverse participants dedicated to learning, engaging, and growing as individuals and a collective. The curriculum encompasses transformative leadership experiences and delves into critical issues such as health and human services, energy and the environment, economic and workforce development, education, tourism, local government, and nonprofit governance. Upon completion, each participant receives a Nonprofit Board Governance certificate. Furthermore, each cohort collaborates to identify, study, and devise innovative and impactful solutions to a chosen issue or concern.

Program Outcomes

Lead Gloucester County is proud to contribute a pool of well-informed, skilled, and resourceful Fellows to the community, poised to become the next generation of leaders in business, nonprofit sectors, government, and community initiatives. Application Process

Interested individuals should submit their completed applications by the end of June. The tuition fee per candidate is \$750, payable in full by the first week of September.
